Ensure that you meet the eligibility requirements prior to applying.

Requirement Type	Requirement Detail
Legal right to the land, or qualifications and rationale for interest in land.	Provide proof of your legal right to the land such as a Certificate of Title or Crown land tenure documents. If no legal right exists, you must provide relevant qualifications and reason for interest in land (e.g., municipal planner, realtor or researcher).
Qualified Archaeological Firm	An archaeologist or GIS staff may request archaeological site data (e.g., when the area of interest exceeds Remote Access to Archaeological Data (RAAD)'s capabilities)

Information Requirements

The following information is required as part of the application process. The requirements for the mandatory authorization(s) are included.

BCeID - What Is It and Why Get It?

BCeID is an online service that allows you to create a user ID and password to sign in securely to many Government services in British Columbia. The benefits of having a BCeID account include:

- Stop and start. Save and return later to complete your application without losing any information previously entered.
- Real time status information. Check the status of your application in real time.
- Access to your applications for multiple people (Business BCeID only). More than one person from your business may edit, submit or check on the status of your application.
